

ELECTROPOP SIZZLER CHRISTER RELEASES DEBUT ALBUM

Toronto, ON - Vancouver-based laptop princess **Christer** is set to ignite the Canadian electropop scene with her debut album ***Techna***, which streets **February 24, 2009**. Recorded at Vertical Studios with notable producer Tom Dobrzanski (*Hey Ocean!*, *Said The Whale*), *Techna* boasts vibrant, thumping dance beats accompanied by a smooth yet sassy vocal style, enticing listeners to get up from their seats and dance.

"Working with Tom and creating this record was such a great experience," says Christer. "I've had amazing support from the Vancouver music community and can't wait to take this dance party across the country!"

Already making waves on the west coast, Christer (pronounced with a hard "I", like "Christ"), has spent 10 weeks on the Canadian national campus and community radio electronic charts with her debut single *How You Like It*. The song has also been featured on the compilation *Manoeuvres 2: A Collection of Vancouver Electronica*.

Techna, though considered an electropop album, doesn't always adhere to pop sensibilities. *Christer is Tronic* is a dark and sultry number that is less electro and more jazz, featuring live guitar, bass and drums. In *Cadaver*, Christer tells a dark story in an upbeat and empowering way by sweetly singing over cheery beats.

Citing influences such as *Miss Kittin*, *Peaches* and *Goldfrapp*, Christer traded in her nine years of classical guitar and songwriting experience for a Macbook, mastering Apple's Garageband program and churning out her brand of infectious electro beats. With the upcoming release of *Techna* it seems this standout talent is well on her way to joining the ranks of her idols.
